

Travel Meet Ethics

- Coaches are unable to chaperone unaccompanied athletes during National Championships or Jr Olympics.
- Families can pair up in hotel rooms to lower travel cost.
- In room share situations, we do not recommend giving money to another parent. Always pay the hotel directly and get a receipt.
- Parents who are unable to attend National meets must designate another parent to chaperone their child.

The following rules must be followed for unaccompanied athletes:

- 1. The parent must pay their share of the hotel. (The cost will be determined by dividing the # of people in the room by the price of the room).
- 2. The parent must send \$30 per day for the cost of food.
- 3. The chaperone must communicate to the parent about all fun extra activities that they will be doing, so that the child will have enough money for those fun activities.

Please do not assume that anyone will cover the costs for your child no matter how friendly you are with that person!!!

The person chaperoning your child is doing you a favor, so please do not put them into an uncomfortable position.

If you are unable to comply with ANY of the above requirements, then we will not enter your child in a meet that you cannot attend.
